

# **VIR 110**

## **COMPOSITION**

Avian Encephalomyelitis, live attenuated virus Calnek 1143 strain of SPF-egg origin.

The minimum antigenic titre is 10<sup>4.0</sup> CID<sub>50</sub> per dose.

#### **INDICATIONS**

Live freeze-dried vaccine for active immunization of future layers and breeding stock (chickens & turkeys) against Avian Encephalomyelitis. Duration of active immunity: entire laying period.

Onset of active immunity: 5 weeks.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Use by instruction of a veterinarian.

The vaccine is recommended for administration by drinking water method

Use reconstituted vaccine immediately and within 2 hours at most. **Preparation** 

Preparation

All equipment used for vaccination should be carefully cleaned and

- be free of detergents and disinfectants.

  Deprive the birds of drinking water two hours before vaccination.
- Prepare an adequate volume of drinking water to be consumed within one or two hours.
- Protect the dissolved vaccine virus from chlorine by adding BIOVAC'S Blue Neutrachlor (following the Instructions).
- Stir well after mixing and allow solution to stand for 20 min., before adding the vaccine to the container.
- Reconstitute the vaccine by drawing 5 ml of cool sterilized or boiled water in a sterile syringe and then transfer this water into the freeze-dried vaccine vial.
  - Allow the vaccine pellet to dissolve completely, gently shake the vaccine vial and then transfer it to a container with disinfectant-free drinking water.

Mix the water containing the vaccine well before use.

 Let the birds consume all the vaccine-water volume before renewing water supply.

#### **PRECAUTIONS**

- Only birds at least 10 weeks of age should be vaccinated.
- Vaccination of layers and breeding stock must be carried out at least 6 weeks before the beginning of the laying period.
- Do not use disinfectants or antiseptics to sterilize any equipment.
- Ensure all vaccination equipment (containers etc.) is carefully cleaned and is free of detergents and disinfectants.
- Wear protective clothing, masks, gloves, etc. according to hazard standards. Avoid contact of the product with skin, eyes, and mouth.
- Do not eat, drink, or smoke whilst handling the product.

- Wash hands with soap or disinfectant after handling the vaccine. Use entire contents when reconstituted within 2 hours and do not store unused vaccine for later use.
- · Adhere to the vaccination program to obtain optimum results.
- Destroy any unused vaccine and dispose of all the vaccine containers and disposable equipment after use in accordance with national environmental requirements.
- · Do not contaminate rivers, dams, or any water sources with containers or waste

# WARNINGS

- · Withdrawal period: Zero days.
  - Vaccinate healthy chickens only.
- · Do not mix with any other vaccine or immunological product. No information is available on the compatibility of this vaccine with other vaccines or medications.
- · Do not use during lay.
- Keep vaccination records including vaccine batch number.
- In case of accidental ingestion, seek medical advice immediately and show the package insert to the physician.
- · Keep out of reach of children, uninformed persons, and animals.

#### STORAGE

Store and transport refrigerated (2 - 8 °C). Protect from light. Do not freeze.

Do not use this veterinary vaccine after the expiry date which is stated on the vial label

## **PRESENTATION**

Glass vials containing 1000 or 2000 doses. Ten vials per carton box with a package insert. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.

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
